2. The Battle Staff NCO Course is a branch-immaterial functional course for the staff sergeant through master sergeant to prepare them for staff assignments. The course provides training that is relevant to missions, duties, and responsibilities assigned to staff NCOs working in battalion and higher positions, both on the battlefield and in garrison environments. The course is open to all staff sergeants through master sergeants whether they are in an ASI 2S coded position or not, however, NCOs assigned to 2S positions have priority. Battle Staff NCO Course uses the experiential learning model strategy.
