Mission Orders and Troop Leading Procedures**

**Advance Sheet**

**1. SCOPE:**

At the end of this five-hour learning event, you will be able to react rapidly to mission orders assigned to your team in order to meet the commander's intent by employing troop leading procedures. You will have an opportunity to build a new order for a team.

**2. LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

**TLO:** This lesson supports the BLC course TLO-400-BLC, Shape teams/squads to meet operational missions by implementing training management principles.

**ELO:**

**Action:** Apply troop leading procedures (TLP).

**Condition:** As a learner, attending the BLC, using a direct level leadership perspective in new environments, given FM 5-0, activities, handouts, classroom discussions, and an operation order (OPORD).

**Standard:** Apply troop leading procedures (TLP) using the eight-step troop leading procedures to create a fragmentary order and a warning order.
