## How to become an instructor for the Sergeants Major Course...

### Instructor Certification Requirements

- Master's Degree from a Regionally Accredited Institution
- Curriculum Vitae
- CFD-IC within the last three years

### Option 1: You Meet the Requirements for Certification

Submit your **Master's Degree Transcripts**, **Curriculum Vitae (CV)**, and **CFD-IC certificate** to:

**SGM-AFellowshipProgram@army.mil**

Submitted documents are then evaluated and certified by the Dean of Academics for CGSC. After a decision is made, the NCOLCoE will assist to place you on assignment to the SGM-A as an instructor for the SMC, or assist individuals to complete the application process for entry into the Fellowship Program.

### Option 2: Apply to the NCOLCoE and SGM-A Fellowship Program

Whether you currently have a Master's Degree, or not, every Sergeant Major / Command Sergeant Major is welcome to apply to the Fellowship Program to attend either The Pennsylvania State University "**WE ARE**" or Syracuse University "**GO ORANGE**"

Each year, the NCOLCoE and SGM-A select 30 candidates to participate in the Fellowship Program; 15 candidates for each university.
