MODERNIZING THE ARMY LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN 2024

- **Why the change?** ALMS 4.0 is transitioning to a new learning management system, ATIS Learning, to modernize the Army's primary digital learning platform.
- **What is ATIS Learning?** ATIS Learning is a modern and more user friendly learning management system where Soldiers and civilians can assess, complete and manage online training.
- **When will the change occur?** ATIS Learning will launch in JAN 2024. All in-progress course topics must be completed in ALMS 4.0 no later than 4 JAN 2024 by 1700 ET.

WHAT'S NEW?

- **Modernized User Interface** – Feedback from users has been incorporated to address learner pain points, visual cues are more prominent, and buttons/icons are consistent across the system.
- **Improved Course Finding** – Learners now have the option to search for mandatory and elective courses by Course Type, Category, or by entering the course or certification name in the search field on the Catalog page.
- **Print Certificates Easier** – In ATIS Learning users can access, download, and email their most recently acquired certificates directly from the homepage.

- **4 – 19 JAN 2024**
ALMS 4.0 will no longer be accessible after 1700 ET, 4 JAN 2024, to begin ATIS Learning go-live transitioning.
